He advocates a plant-based diet to reduce obesity, control coronary heart disease and manage other conditions, such as diabetes, high blood pressure and certain autoimmune diseases. After becoming 100% plant-based in November, 2012, Dr. Fullin has shed over 60 pounds and enthusiastically promoted plant-strong dietary patterns to his patients and fellow practitioners.
